Cleaning Instructions

Sunbrella® features a soil- and stain-resistant finish that makes cleaning a breeze. Spot wash by sponging briskly with a soapy solution of mild soap in lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry. You can also clean the cover in your washing machine, however do not use your dryer. After the wash cycle, simply put the damp cover back on the frame on the umbrella and let air dry. Solution-dyed acrylic does not promote mildew growth. However, mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. Simply wash your cover to remove mildew.

Sunbrella® Warranty

What is covered? Sunbrella® warrants the fabric from being unserviceable because of loss of color or strength from normal exposure conditions, including sunlight, mildew, rot and atmospheric chemicals. Galtech warrants that the cover shall be free from defects in workmanship. This includes incorrectly stitches seems and runs in the fabric. Runs and tears in the fabric must be reported within 10 days of receipt of product. The warranty coverage runs for 3 years from the date of original purchase.

Q: Is Sunbrella furniture fabric waterproof?

A: Because Sunbrella fabrics are designed to be breathable, they are water repellent but not completely waterproof.

Q: Do Sunbrella furniture fabrics provide UV protection?

A: Sunbrella fabrics have been tested and proven to provide up to 98% UV protection from harmful effects of the sun when used in shade applications. Sunbrella furniture fabrics have been awarded the "Seal of Recommendation" by The Skin Cancer Foundation, an international organization dedicated to the prevention of skin cancer.
